Overview

Each class will focus on comprehending conversational and basic Spanish skills by implementing basic foreign language fundamentals in a nontraditional learning environment. Students will learn real – world applications of Spanish. This will be accomplished through games, songs, and many other interactive activities. Interaction, listening, reading, speaking and team building skills are just a few skills that will be developed with this program.

Objectives

- Be able to understand and communicate all forms of greetings in Spanish, useful phrases and basic survival phrases.
- Have a basic vocabulary covering verbs(er, ir, ar) emotions, likes dislikes, and courtesy expressions.
- Recognize and know what definite articles to use.
- Comprehend and communicate basic survival and urgent phrases
- Learn their colors, alphabet, counting from 0 -100, telephone number exchange and age exchange in Spanish.
- Identify and interpret family members, body parts, people, food items, calendar months, days of the week, seasons in Spanish.
- Experience cultural aspects from different Spanish-speaking countries.
- Focus on teamwork, building bonds and friendships.
